## Need further persuasion . . .

Here are the specific goals and objectives of the workshop presenter, Carl Olson. If your administration wants to know why you need to attend--here are the reasons.

### **A Toolbox for Teaching and Advising by Carl Olson**

Good teaching produces effective outcome, requiring the teacher to have knowledge of the subject matter. To be effective, that material must be presented using methods that acknowledge and respect all learning styles and levels of attention.

*"Tell me and I will forget."*

*"Show me and I may remember"*

*"Involve me and I will understand."*

In this workshop I will present information and practical examples of how to get to the level of understanding. The workshop will provide the participants ways to:

- acquire strategies to enhance school standardized test scores
- learn 3 types of experiential activities and how to use them to enhance learning
- examine timely, relevant resources for future study
- energize and recharge themselves and their staff, for the challenges of teaching and educational collaboration
- practice proven techniques and activities for making more in depth teacher/learner connections
- understand the importance of team building and group engagement to improve student success
- take home new experiential tools to directly apply to the individual teaching situation
- examine the experiential learning cycle and the teacher's role at each stage
- relate activity center teaching to accept brain based learning research
- identify methods for putting fun into learning
- practice and understand the three levels of effective processing and the relationship to desired learner outcomes.

### **Learner Objectives**

This "Energizer Olson" seminar/workshop will involve active participation using the experiential approach. My goal is to have all participants leave with knowledge and practical tools that they can use and share in their educational setting. As stated earlier one of my goals is to make it valuable and fun while accomplishing the following objectives:

1. The participants will understand three types of experiential activities and when and how to apply them.
2. The participants will learn techniques for improving client engagement and connection.
3. The participants will understand the relationship between experiential methods and brain-based learning research.
4. The participants will be able to apply the three levels of processing to their teaching and learning.
5. the participants will be presented with a comprehensive list of resources for further study.
